## 1. We need a **clean** Dream Act.

- a. This means a just, compassionate path to citizenship for Dreamers unburdened by demands for massive & unnecessary spending on border security.
- b. The security of our Dreamers, which includes nearly an estimated 4,000 Cornhuskers, is a separate issue from border security. These Dreamers are already here, already a vital part of our community, & they are upstanding neighbors who have clean records that USCIS has already vetted.

## 2. Our Dreamers *deserve* a **clean** Dream Act.

- a. Dreamers are some of the hardest working members of our community. They are ambitious in their pursuit of education, making Dreamers the very people we need to keep & value in our country, and in Nebraska in particular.
- b. Dreamers not only invigorate our community with their diverse backgrounds and talents, but also with their economic contributions. The United States stands to lose an estimated annual GDP loss of \$460.3 billion, and Nebraska stands to lose an estimated annual GDP loss of \$150,222,996, if we do not fight for our Dreamers with a clean Dream Act now.

## 3. We deserve a **clean** Dream Act.

- a. We Nebraskans value hard work and family. We are a compassionate, kind state. Nebraskans deserve to be proud of the legislation our state supports, & it should reflect our family values & work ethic.
- b. It's important to us that our brothers, sisters, friends, children, & parents are safe and have the opportunity to flourish—whether or not they are Dreamers. But it is the Dreamer population, which has contributed so much to our community, that is now endanger. Help us protect our Dreamers—we deserve a clean Dream Act.
